Conditions of Membership

In making application to the Kennel Union of Southern Africa for membership, I/We make the following statements and agree to comply with the following conditions:

- At all times I/we will conform to the Bylaws, Policies, Procedures, Code of Ethics, Rules & Regulations of the KUSA;
- I/We have never been convicted on a charge of cruelty to or neglect of animals;
- I/We confirm that I/we am/are not now nor ever have been suspended or expelled by KUSA, or any club, registry body or association concerned with animals.
- I/We will pay with this application for membership the initial entry fee plus the fee for a 12 month subscription and thereafter an annual membership fee as then prescribed in the Schedule of Subscriptions and Fees of the KUSA.
- I/We understand and agree that having voluntarily submitted this application, the KUSA is under no obligation to arbitrarily approve it.

Note:

All fees include VAT at the current rate for residents & non residents, alike. Should the VAT rate be altered fees will be amended accordingly.

EXPLANATIONS

- "Membership Year" runs for twelve months from the month in which you were elected.
- A "Household" is defined as a maximum of five (5) people living at the same physical address (P.O. Box or Private Bag is not counted as a physical address), though you can have your mail sent there.
- A "Senior" is defined as a person of over seventy (70) seventy years of age (Proof of age must be produced when applying for this membership fee).
- A "Junior" is defined as a person over eight (8) and under eighteen (18) years of age on the date of application for or renewal of membership, (Proof of age must be produced when applying for this membership fee).
- Personal Identity (Book of Life) Numbers
These are needed as it has been found that people are inconsistent in the use of initials, addresses and in the case of ladies even marital status and surname resulting in the same person appearing more than once on the computer records. Unless otherwise advised all communications to you will be sent to the initials, name and address on this application form, which will be linked to your I.D. number.
